Diverse scholarly thoughts on the methodology of the budding academic field of Islamic economics in comparative study spanning the form of research papers, conceptual papers, and applied ones are welcome. In this small contributed session that is planned within the total programme of the most prestigious 19th World Congress of the International Economic Association, descriptive and analytical papers of scholarly depth are invited for an intellectual interchange of ideas and discourse in all fields of economics and their attenuating relationship with themes of morality, ethics, religion, culture, philosophy, analytical and mathematical orientation having methodological worldview.

Islamic Economics as a budding field of intellectual investigation is still in search of its methodology. The result thereby is to call for exchange of views by the most rigorous approach combining transdisciplinary fields framing the methodological depth pertaining to all fields of economics. This is likewise true of the general theoretical area of economics discoursed from a new epistemological viewpoint.

Thus a comparative study of the budding new economic worldview is part of the objective of this learned contributed session along with its component of Islamic Economics. The resulting wide field of paper presentation along with the specific focus in Islamic Economics will together span the comparative inquiry in a conformable way. The emergent new epistemic and economic outlook forms the methodological study of moral/ethical embedding in economic issues in general and Islamic economics in particular from conceptual and empirical perspectives. In this light all fields of economics with new horizons of methodological thought would be included. Graduate students and colloquium by preparatory doctoral and master degree students are welcome to contribute their papers for consideration.

All papers contributed will undergo a preliminary selection for inclusion in the session. Subsequently, papers presented in this contributed session will be refereed for inclusion in a Special Issue: New Horizons of Economic Thought of the International Journal of Ethics and Systems (Emerald Publications).
